Case Competition Format and Rules



Submitted case should:

- A title that clears states the solution and a summary section that captures the key contents of the case
- Include all team members' names and email addresses; include name of the team, if any
- Acknowledge everyone who is not a team member but has contributed to the case
- Properly cite literature/publications used in the case
- <5,000 words (not counting words used in captions to Figures and Graphs; Use of Infographics encouraged)
- PDF format; indicate word count at the end.
- No requirements on everything else.

Case Competition Format and Rules



Overall judging criteria:

- Ingenuity, practicality, enforceability
- Prefer: cases that include no more than 2 solutions but with each rigorously argued and well supported by research, facts and statistics.
- DO NOT prefer: cases that have many solutions but sparse on detail and depth on each solution.
